Section A Application requirements

The Monash South Africa bursary process occurs once a year in January. Successful applicants will be notified in February.

The closing date for application is **17:00 (South African time), Friday the 31st of October 2008.**

To apply you need to:

- Complete the application form;
- Sign the declaration;
- Attach all relevant supporting documentation as specified; and
- Return to the Student Accounts Officer by the closing date

Note: No late applications or supporting documentation will be accepted.

Section B Eligibility and supporting documentation

Monash South Africa bursaries are available to **South African students only** who can provide supporting documentation detailing extreme financial hardship.

Eligibility criteria:

To be eligible for a Monash South Africa bursary you must:

- I. be **enrolled** or have received an **offer to enrol** as a full-time student at Monash South Africa in a foundation programme or an undergraduate course of study leading to a higher education award;
- II. not be a recipient of any other financial support award;
- III. be studying Year 12 or equivalent (South African citizens) or be studying in the final year of secondary school or equivalent (international); **or**
- IV. be a current Monash South African student and have completed a minimum of one semester of study at Monash South Africa

Supporting documentation:

- Certified copy of Identification document/Passport;
- Certified copy of latest academic results;
- Certified copy of payslips for the individual/s who will be held responsible for payment of your fees **or** a signed affidavit if he/she is unemployed
- Two reference letters from friends, family members or acquaintances; and
- Motivation letter for why you would be a worthy candidate for a Monash South Africa bursary.

Note: If you do not supply all required supporting documentation your application will be rejected immediately.
