- Attach all relevant supporting documentation as specified; and
- Return to the Academic Services Officer by the closing date

Section B Eligibility and supporting documentation

Monash South Africa scholarships are available to **South African** and **International students**. Scholarships are offered to students to encourage and reward **academic excellence** in previous studies.

Eligibility criteria:

To be eligible for a Monash South Africa scholarship you must:

- be **enrolled** or have received an **offer to enrol** as a full-time student at Monash South Africa in a foundation programme or an undergraduate course of study leading to a higher education award;
- not be a recipient of any other financial support award;
- be studying Year 12 or equivalent (South Africa citizen) or be studying in the final year of secondary school or equivalent (international); **or**
- be a current Monash South Africa student and have completed a minimum of one semester of study at Monash South Africa;

Supporting documentation:

- Certified copy of Identification document/Passport;
- Certified copy of latest academic results;

- Two reference letters from friends, family members or acquaintances; and
- Motivation letter for why you would be a worthy candidate for a Monash South Africa scholarship.
